

§ 50.02 UTILITY BILLS; COLLECTIONS.

Charges for utility services provided by or through the city shall be billed jointly on a monthly basis. The Utility Superintendent shall read, or cause to be read, water, gas and electric meters on or around the fifteenth day of each month. Utility bills shall be mailed on or around the last day of each month, and shall be due upon receipt and payable by the fifteenth of each month. Bills paid after the fifteenth day of each month shall have a penalty charge added thereto in an amount set by resolution of the City Council and on file in the office of the City Clerk or Utilities Superintendent. Bills not paid prior to a 10 day period after the penalty has been assessed shall be deemed to be delinquent. Upon being deemed to be delinquent, the city may discontinue service pursuant to § 50.03. Once discontinued, service shall not be recommended except upon payment of a reconnection fee in an amount set by resolution of the City Council. The city may also take any action authorized by law to effect collection of delinquent charges.
